Individual Funding

Donations

- often one-time and boundless
- rarely connected to the project needs
- no guarentee of impact

Crowdfunding

- relatively new, popular
- all-or-nothing and one-time
- on-going with various levels
- less effective for public goods





Individual Funding

Pledge Drives

- very effective without threshold
- requires wide-reaching communication
- maximized with matching, adds influence concerns

Bounties and Commissions

- will make progress ... for a price
- restricts creativity
- potential for sabotage
- has not seen much success





Institutional Funding

Grants

- social good and avoid taxes
- restrictive terms
- too much money to deal with
- leaves vacuum

Sponsorship

- direct with strings and limitations
- indirect through employment
- subtle influence

Taxes

- greatest source for public goods
- political and bureaucratic arguments
- poor distribution leading to underfunding



Malicious

Provided "free of charge" in exchange for making you the product through manipulation and surviellance.


